We are currently accepting applications for the 2018 Youth Citizen Police Academy.

When: June 4th – 8th, 2018

9:00am-1:30pm (lunch will be provided Monday -Thursday)

Where: Schaumburg Police Department.

Requirements: Live or attend school in the Village of Schaumburg and be between the ages of 13-17.

Cost: FREE

This program provides an opportunity for students to learn about law enforcement and develop a partnership with the police department. Through this one week academy, students will acquire knowledge through both classroom instruction and an interactive curriculum surrounding the law enforcement profession. The Academy is not a boot camp or a program for rebellious teens or youth who have behavioral issues. It provides area youth with a unique learning opportunity with their local police officers.

All students will receive a certificate of completion and CPR certification. A Youth Citizen Police Academy t-shirt will be provided. On Friday from noon-1:00pm, parents are invited to the Police Department for a graduation ceremony where students will be presented their Academy Certificate, followed by cake and coffee.
